Discounts and offers

We offer a 5% sibling discount to the younger sibling.

We offer a 5% discount for a full-time place (already included on the table above)

Early Years Entitlement (Funded Hours) for 3 & 4 year olds

The government funded hours or Early Years Entitlement for 3 & 4 year olds starts the term after the child's 3rd birthday. This funding is for 38 weeks a year (term time only). Working parents are usually entitled to 30 funded hours a week, lower income families are usually entitled to 15 hours funding a week.

Here at Farfield Nursery, for children only receiving 15 hours a week funded by the government for 38 weeks, term time only- we offer this funding for 51 weeks! The extra 13 weeks (school holidays) is entirely funded by Farfield Nursery!*

For those children claiming the 30 hours funding provided by the government for 38 weeks, term time only, here at Farfield Nursery we give you an additional 15 hours a week FREE during school holidays. (That is a full day and an afternoon 'knocked off' your fees!) This is completely funded by Farfield Nursery, no other nursery offers these free hours. Our daily rate is lower than the local nurseries and covers the entire day; 7:30am-6:00pm, there are no extra charges for starting before 8:00am or collecting after 5:00pm.

In addition to this, here at Farfield Nursery, we offer 15 hours a week free from the month after your child's 3rd birthday, and not the term after.*

*The offers from Farfield are only for children claiming all their funded hours at Farfield Nursery. If the funding is split with another provider, these offers do not apply.

There is a daily 'top-up' charge for those claiming Free Early Education Entitlement (30 hours funding) : £5.50 per day.

£5.50 per day x 3 days x 38 weeks divided by 12 months: £52.25 monthly

We have resisted this change for several years but can no longer avoid this due to increasing costs. The funding from Bradford does not cover meal and meal preparation costs.

There will be no additional charges for those only claiming 15 hours a week 2 & 3 & 4-year-old funding entitlement.

Please see the examples below for fees from April 2021 for those claiming 30 hours funding. Remember at Farfield you will also get an additional 15 hours a week free during school holidays.

15 hours a week funding for 3 & 4 year olds

If you are entitled to 15 hours a week funding, you can still have 15 hours a week free all year. 15 hours a week term time only, funded by Bradford Council and 15 hours a week during school holidays funded by Farfield Nursery.

2 year old funding

You may find out if you are eligible for 2 year old funding by looking on the Bradford Council website, search for '2 year old funding Bradford'. The 15 hours funding for eligible 2 year olds will continue to be term time only.
